

Main Street scarf

a free pattern from Fairmount Fibers
designed by Elizabeth Nields



FINISHED SIZE

2 1/4" x 81", plus ruffles

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay SILK BLEND (70% superfine merino, 30% silk; 50g, approx. 150 yds): 2 sk MC, 1 sk each A, B, and C. Shown in 300G Coffee (MC), 3064 Pewter (A), 3207 Willow (B), and 3029 Steel (C).

Circular needle, 29" or longer, US6/4mm OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

GAUGE

22 sts and 27 rows = 4"/10cm in pattern (Scarf will stretch lengthwise once ruffles are added.)

GARTER AND RIB PATTERN (odd number of sts)

Rows 1 – 5: Knit.

Rows 6, 8, and 10 (RS): K2; *p1, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Rows 7 and 9: K1; *p1, k1; rep from * to end of row.

Rep rows 1 – 10 for Garter and Rib Pattern.

RUFFLE

Row 1 (RS): (Knit into front, back, then front again) of each stitch.

Rows 2 and 4: Purl.

Rows 3 and 5: Knit.

Row 6: BO knitwise.

NOTE

Scarf is worked horizontally. Ruffles are picked up and worked when scarf is complete.

SCARF

Using MC, CO 335 sts. Work 20 rows in Garter and Rib Pattern, then knit 4 rows. BO knitwise, using larger needle if necessary to keep bound-off edge loose. Block scarf.

Make ruffles: Using A, with RS facing, in center of garter band at top of scarf pick up one st for each purl "bump" in middle garter ridge. Work rows 1 – 6 of Ruffle. Using B, with RS facing, pick up in center garter band and work ruffle as before. Using C, with RS facing, pick up sts in bottom garter band and work ruffle as before.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
